### Two different ways to enjoy the Photo Walks:

- PHOTO WALKS « OPEN » : starting at 30€ per person. Guaranteed departure with a minimum of 5 participants.

Prices may vary if the number of participants is under 5 persons. Please check with me prior.

- PHOTO WALKS «ONE TO ONE»: A private outing for discovery or photography. Available all year upon request.

Prices: 150€ from 1 to 3 persons. 200€ from 4 to 8 persons. 10€ for each additional person up to 12 persons.

A PLUS for the ONE TO ONEs: Choose the itinerary & the time of day that suit you best.

Meals, beverages, entrances and lifts taken during a ONE TO ONE walk are not included in the price.

**Duration of the walks**: Plan on 3 - 3 ½ hours, depending on the itinerary. Pleasant walking on small village roads and snowy country paths. Warm shoes with good soles. Walking or ski poles are advised. Useful heating packets for gloves, too. Transportation to the rendez-vous spot: by train in the valley (free with the carte d'hôtes) or by car-pool. In the event of very poor weather: A replacement date will be proposed during the week if possible.
